



RESOLUTION FOR A REFERENDUM ON TEXAS INDEPENDENCE

WHEREAS, The Republic of Texas existed as an independent nation for nine years, and when it accepted admission to the Union in 1845, it remained a free and independent state subject only to the United States Constitution; and

WHEREAS, The United States Congress has passed laws requiring Texas to make expenditures that are unfunded by the federal government, which is a violation of the Tenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution; moreover, the federal government has caused the intentional devaluation of its currency through its reckless spending and borrowing, and this threatens the economic stability of Texas; and

WHEREAS, The United States government has allowed the use of its authority, credit, and goodwill for the benefit of private and foreign concerns in violation of its own constitution; in addition, its repeated failure to guard the border between Texas and Mexico has forced the state to spend vast sums in order to protect its citizens; and

WHEREAS, The federal government has further implemented thousands of laws, mandates, and agencies in violation of the United States Constitution and of the sovereignty of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article I, Texas Constitution, states that "the perpetuity of the Union depend[s] upon the preservation of the right of local self-government, unimpaired to all the States"; Section 2, Article I, declares, "All political power is inherent in the people, and all free governments are founded on their authority, and instituted for their benefit. The faith of the people of Texas stands pledged to the preservation of a republican form of government, and, subject to this limitation only, they have at all times the inalienable right to alter, reform or abolish their government in such manner as they may think expedient"; now,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the _____ Party of Texas urges the State of Texas to hold a referendum asking the people of Texas to decide on whether or not ***the State of Texas should reassert its status as an independent nation.***

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the _____ Senatorial/County Convention Resolutions Committee from Precinct #_____ of the _____ County _____ Party, with the recommendation that it be passed and sent to the State Convention Platform Committee of the _____ Party of Texas.



RESOLUTION FOR A BAN ON OUT-OF-STATE CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS

WHEREAS, Article 1 Section 1 of the Texas Constitution declares that Texas is a free and independent State; and

WHEREAS, Article 1 Section 2 of the Texas Constitution declares that all political power in Texas is inherent in the people; and

WHEREAS, There are massive amounts of campaign contributions that flow into campaign coffers for elected positions in the State of Texas from contributors that live outside of Texas whose purpose is to manipulate the outcome of Texas elections; and

WHEREAS, These campaign contributions constitute foreign interference in our elections and are a direct threat to the sovereignty of our State; and

WHEREAS, The outcome of Texas elections should be solely determined by Texans; now,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the _____ Party of Texas urges the State of Texas to pass legislation which bans campaign contributions and expenditures that originate from outside the State of Texas including individuals, organizations, and political action committees.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the _____ Senatorial/County Convention Resolutions Committee from Precinct #_____ of the _____ County _____ Party, with the recommendation that it be passed and sent to the State Convention Platform Committee of the _____ Party of Texas.
